Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is available in the form of scholarships, need based financial aid, and work-study. The majority of funds are distributed according to financial need rather than academic merit.

Need Based Assistance

Apply to FACTS Management (an independent agency). Application and directions are available on our website. This is due mid-December using your tax returns from the previous year.

Work Study

Students are assigned work in building maintenance, front office jobs, etc. Work is performed before and after school, on weekends, and during the summer. Student must actually do the work before receiving a credit on their tuition statement.
